Encased in a low profile aluminum enclosure that includes two knock-outs for easy installation, it's the perfect choice for low-voltage under cabinet lights, tape lights and various LED fixture installations. Driver features auto reset, over current and short circuit protection, and an efficiency of 90% or higher for operation at low temperatures.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Note: This dimmable transformer requires a *compatible MLV/Incandescent TRIAC (leading edge) dimmer switch* for proper operation. See the list of approved dimmers recommended by Magnitude Inc. and Inspired LED for more details. Driver must be installed in a well-ventilated area free from explosive gasses and vapors. Proper operation requires a free flow of air. Driver should be installed by a qualified electrician in accordance with article 450 of the National Electrical Code.

Precautions Before Installing

Check the label to ensure the driver has the proper input voltage and wattage for the job. Check the wire markings to ensure they match the wiring diagram below.

Input Connections/Grounding

Remove the wiring compartment cover and install the clamp connectors provided with the driver. With power turned off, route the input wires through the clamp connector and connect one wire to black and one wire to white. For all wire connections use only UL listed wire nuts and connectors of suitable size and style. Connect the ground wire to the driver green wire, the driver case MUST be grounded in accordance with N.E.C..


Output Connections

Bring the wires of the light fixture through the other clamp connector and connect them to the driver wire: positive to the red (+) wire and negative to the blue (-) wire.

Mounting

Select a location capable of supporting the weight of the driver. Use the two keyholes in in the driver case to mount using suitable screws. It is recommended that the driver be mounted vertically with the wiring compartment pointing down.
