





Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature








Figure 2. On–Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. On–Resistance Variation with Gate–to–Source Voltage





Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature
